Dear Ms Friedeman:

This letter is to recommend the water system at the Nemo Work Center, PWS EPA ID# 8083, be reclassified from a Public Transient Non-Community system to a Public Non-Transient Non-Community system.

A review of the Nemo water system indicates a total of 12 service connections on this system serving 20 year-round residents, 9 year-round daily work place users, and 20-30 seasonal users (May through September).

Daily service is currently provided as follows:

- Service Connection #1: Troxell Residence #1; 3 year-round residents,
- Service Connection #2: Troxell Residence #2; 3 year-round residents,
- Service Connection #3: Adams Residence; 2 year-round residents,
- Service Connection #4: Forest Service Bunkhouse # 1; 2 to 3 seasonal FS employees (approximately 120 days per year),
- Service Connection #5: Forest Service Bunkhouse # 2; 2 to 3 seasonal FS employees (approximately 120 days per year),
- Service Connection #6: Krahn Residence; 2 year-round residents,
- Service Connection #7: Nemo Work Center Shop; 2 year-round FS employees,
- Service Connection #8: Bed & Breakfast (the old schoolhouse); 8 year-round residents plus up to 20 guests per day during the tourist season,
- Service Connection #9: Church; 10 to 20 people once a week for Sunday service plus periodic special events,
- Service Connection #10: Nemo Community Center; 10 to 20 people every Friday Night Fish Fry plus periodic special events,
- Service Connection #11: Post Office/Fire Department; 7 year-round Post Office and Fire Department employees,
- Service Connection #12: Hood Residence; 2 year-round residents.
